first time to teach at Ironmen – the non-controversial, easy subject of should women work outside the home –

This time – how to lead your family

I never do get the easy subjects

 how to be a Christian at work – how to read your Bible better - etc.

I get the ones that either get me death threats – or create deeper expectations at home

I don't want to teach this seminar – and I need to teach this seminar

- there was that day when I had that conversation with my wife – "what are you teaching at Ironmen" –
- she is very interested in what I am going to say
- great, godly wife who expects me to apply everything
 I say from the pulpit not content to let me sound good without being good

I am always excited to come to Ironmen – especially when I am not teaching at Ironmen – it is more convicting for me to teach than to merely come

So – I am a learner in this process – I am a plagiarizer in this subject – I would rather listen on this subject – I am not an expert

 many of you have been married longer than me – better husbands than me – better shepherds than me

My aim is to merely share from God's word and some practical implications

Let's not make this more than it should be – nor less than it should be.

What we are talking about here:

Consistently living out your Christianity at home.

- with your wife and children

No secrets – not something different for a Husband, than a Pastor, than an employee/employer

 the other seminars should be emphasizing some of the same things – how do you live out the Word of God because of the impact of the gospel in a particular context of life

Be a consistent Christian in your home.

I. BE BIBLICALLY THOUGHTFUL ABOUT YOUR LEADERSHIP AT HOME

1. Be biblically thoughtful about your role at home

Isn't

- formally Pastor, Priest, King, Savior
- do not exclude these formal roles from influencing your home with the thought that you are all of these things to your family
- In practical ways You might be a shepherd, an interceder, a leader, and a provider – but you are not the sole Pastor, Intermediary, Sovereign, or Redeemer of your family
- Let the community of Christ and the Person of Christ have their respective roles in your life and in the life of your family

Remember the context of the Body of Christ analogy – you need others to be complete – you are not an all-sufficient source of Spirituality for your family

- know your place -

ls:

Leader – 1 Cor 11:3 – leader not source – you are a leader under leaders – but, yes, you must lead

Lover – Eph 5:25ff; Col 3:19 – see the Gospel-context of these – these are results – don't make them live on their own

Discipler – Matt 28:19ff – apply the Great Commission to your home

Provider - get the audio of my seminar from 2 years ago

Protector – Gen 2 & 3 – protect from spiritual and practical danger

Servant – Phil 2:3ff – how do you apply this at home

 even in practical issues like intimacy – Scripture says your role is a self-sacrificial servant who finds personal joy in satisfying another – not in demanding for yourself – 1 Cor 7

2. Be biblically thoughtful about the impact of the curse on your home

Gen 3 & 4

- the difficulties of work will challenge you
- your leadership will be challenged
- your children's natural heart direction will challenge you

3. Be biblically thoughtful about the gospel's implications in your home

You are insufficient - Christ is all sufficient

The gospel is first about God and restoring his glory as the priority of life – don't live in a manner otherwise

God should be your consuming priority

The Gospel is what overcomes the curse's challenges

4. Be biblically thought about the Bible's priorities in your home

Glorify God

Make disciples

Love Your Wife

Shape Your children

All I am emphasizing here is to remind yourself of what Scripture emphasizes – get this in your head

Secondly – you need to do this in a purposefully intentional way with your family:
